KineFLUX

The KineFLUX project was started by Handicap International with the aim of improving the living conditions of refugees with disabilities. It was soon extended to all destitute people.

DoucheFLUX, which took over the programme in October 2020, is an association that aims to stop destitute people being marginalised, whether they are homeless or living in substandard accommodation, whether their papers are in order or not, wherever they come from. At the heart of its mission is the human being and human dignity. This means that the target group has been enlarged to include all destitute people who cannot access this type of health care.

Job description

You will work with migrants and/or destitute people in premises managed by DoucheFLUX, in close coordination with the health professionals working in the centre.

You will demonstrate openness: your patients can be of any gender, age, origin and religion. You will need to be versatile and adapt to the needs of your patients, many of whom suffer from musculoskeletal pain resulting from past traumas, and who are treated at the centre for varying periods of time. You will report on your activities to DoucheFLUX, while coordinating your work with the medical teams of DWB and the medical centre Medikuregem.

Duties

1. Rehabilitation services for destitute people:

- Carrying out assessments of people referred to you by your colleagues in order to identify their physiological limits and their most urgent needs in terms of rehabilitation.
- Implementing rehabilitation care in collaboration with other team members.
- Following up patients under your care in order to improve their autonomy and well-being.

2. Planning, internal coordination, communication:

- Coordinating and sharing information with the medical team in order to optimise the treatment of the patients, and where appropriate referring them for further treatment.
- Keeping a written record of the therapy performed.
- Participating in any multidisciplinary meetings which might be arranged.

Qualifications

- You are a qualified practitioner experienced in your field and have a license to practice your profession in Belgium. You work rigorously, have a good working relationship with the other practitioners, and coordinate your work with the other health workers.
- You are motivated and flexible, you commit to working fixed shifts, you are punctual, and you like human contact and teamwork.
- Working languages: French, with the possibility of interpreting occasionally. Knowledge of any other language (English, Arabic, Dari, Pashtun, etc.) would be an asset.

Working condition

- Specificity: half day or full day, according to your availability.
- Conditions : Voluntary work, tailored briefing, training and adaptation to context.
